IMPORTANT NOTES RELATING TO YOUR OMA DUES PAYMENTS

If you are on an **Annual Payment Plan for PAD or Credit Card**, your payment will be processed on the **first business day in January**.

If you are on a **Monthly Payment Plan** your payments will be processed on the **15th** of the month or the next business day.

CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

CATEGORY	GUIDELINES
PART TIME PRACTICE	This fee category is available to those physicians who earn less than \$80,000 per year in net professional income. You may be asked to provide additional details. NOTE: You must re-apply for this category every year
FIRST YEAR IN PRACTICE	This fee category is available to all physicians who: a) are in the first year of practice or health research after completing a formal training program, or b) begin a new speciality practice after a period of formal training. It is not available for physicians who: a) relocate their practice to Ontario, or b) take short term training other than a formal residency program and return essentially to the same practice
SECOND YEAR IN PRACTICE	This fee category is available to all physicians who are in their second year of practice or health research after completing a period of formal training.
RESIDENT & POSTGRAD STUDENT	This fee category is available to licensed physicians who are currently involved in medical training or in training for another profession in Ontario, either as an alternative or as an addition to medicine. It does not apply to medical students, or physicians undertaking short term training programs of less than one year.
MEDICAL STUDENT	This fee category is available to medical students who are enrolled in one of the Ontario Faculties of Medicine and to international medical graduates enrolled in a formal pre-residency training program.
NON-RESIDENT REGULAR	This fee category is available to physicians who do not work in Ontario and wish to maintain ALL relevant benefits of membership. Non-Resident Members do not have the right to vote in any election of the Association. If you practice both inside and outside Ontario, this category is not applicable.
NON-RESIDENT INSURANCE ONLY	This fee category is available to physicians who do not work in Ontario and wish to maintain eligibility for OMA Insurance ONLY. Non-Resident Members do not have the right to vote in any election of the Association or be a member of any OMA Section, Medical Interest Group or Forum. Note: If you practice both inside and outside Ontario, this category is not applicable.
RETIRED	This fee category is available to physicians who are retired (not working for remuneration).
INACTIVE	This fee category is available to physicians who have left practice for a period of at least one year, although they may intend to return to practice in the future. NOTE: You must re-apply for this category every year
NON-CLINICAL PRACTICE	This fee category is available to physicians working outside clinical medicine (for example, administrators, teachers, and consultants). It also applies to physicians who are practising clinical medicine in the armed forces or federal civil service and maintain a sideline or occasional independent practice.
INDIVIDUAL ASSESSMENT	The Board of Directors may waive or reduce dues if the payment will result in undue financial hardship. The amount of dues shall be specified by the Board of Directors in a particular case. Please contact membership@oma.org to apply for this category.
OMA LIFE OR HONORARY MEMBER	Longstanding members elected by the Board of Directors of OMA in recognition of outstanding service to the profession and/or the community
MEDICAL MISSIONARY	Physicians engaged in missionary work with a recognized religious or charitable agency for little or no remuneration.
COMPLIMENTARY	Members age 75 at January 1, 2021, having been born in 1945 or earlier and having paid OMA dues in at least 10 of the previous 20 years.
